Svoltadonna hosted 97 women from the beginning of April 2023 to April 2024. They have had 11 women with 14 children inserted into the system.

FAWCO awards about 9 Development Grants recipients annually. We can consider moving forward with local organizations we would like to support in applying for these grants in the Fall.

FAWCO Target Project



The FAWCO Target Environment 2022-2025 Project has been a sustainable investment by FAWCO members to empower women and girls. In 2022 IWCT voted from the short list of candidates. Funds raised till 2025 will support the Target Environment Project, Awesome Blossoms.

This coming year in March a new Target Project will be elected for the upcoming three year period.

Awesome Blossoms, Edible Fresh Fields for Sustainable Life in the Slums, an Urban Farming Project. This is an initiative taken to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and limit the negative impacts of climate change in the Mathare slums of Nairobi, Kenya.
